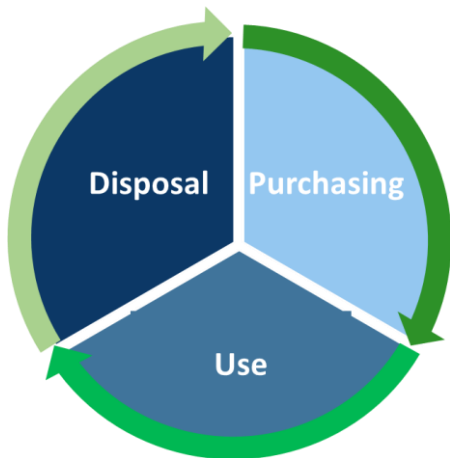




Key principles
